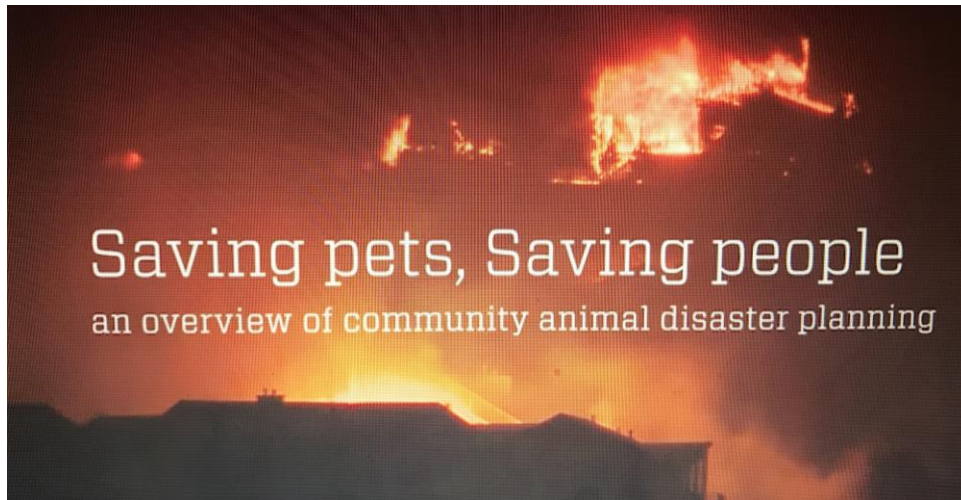

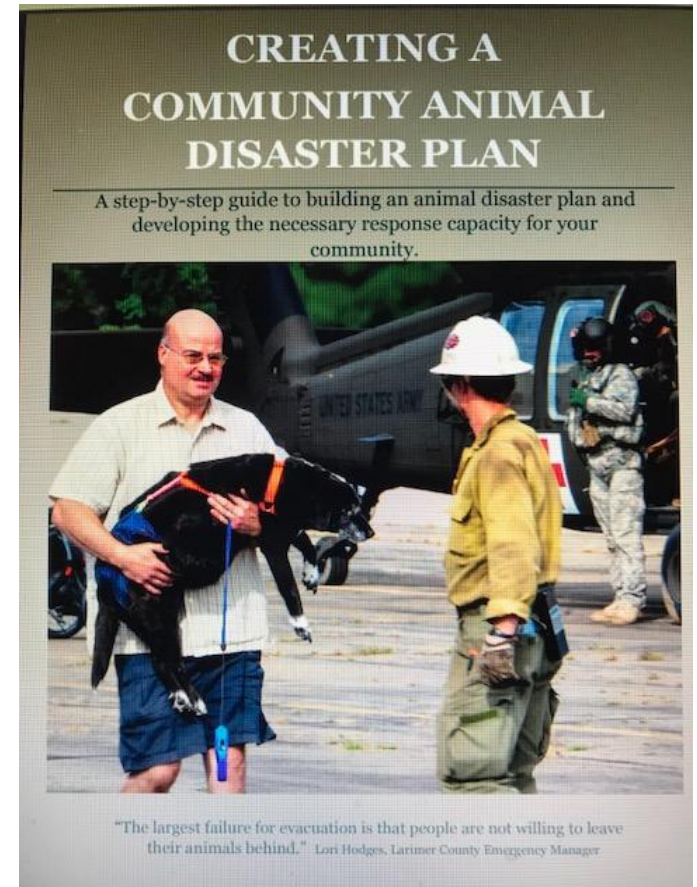

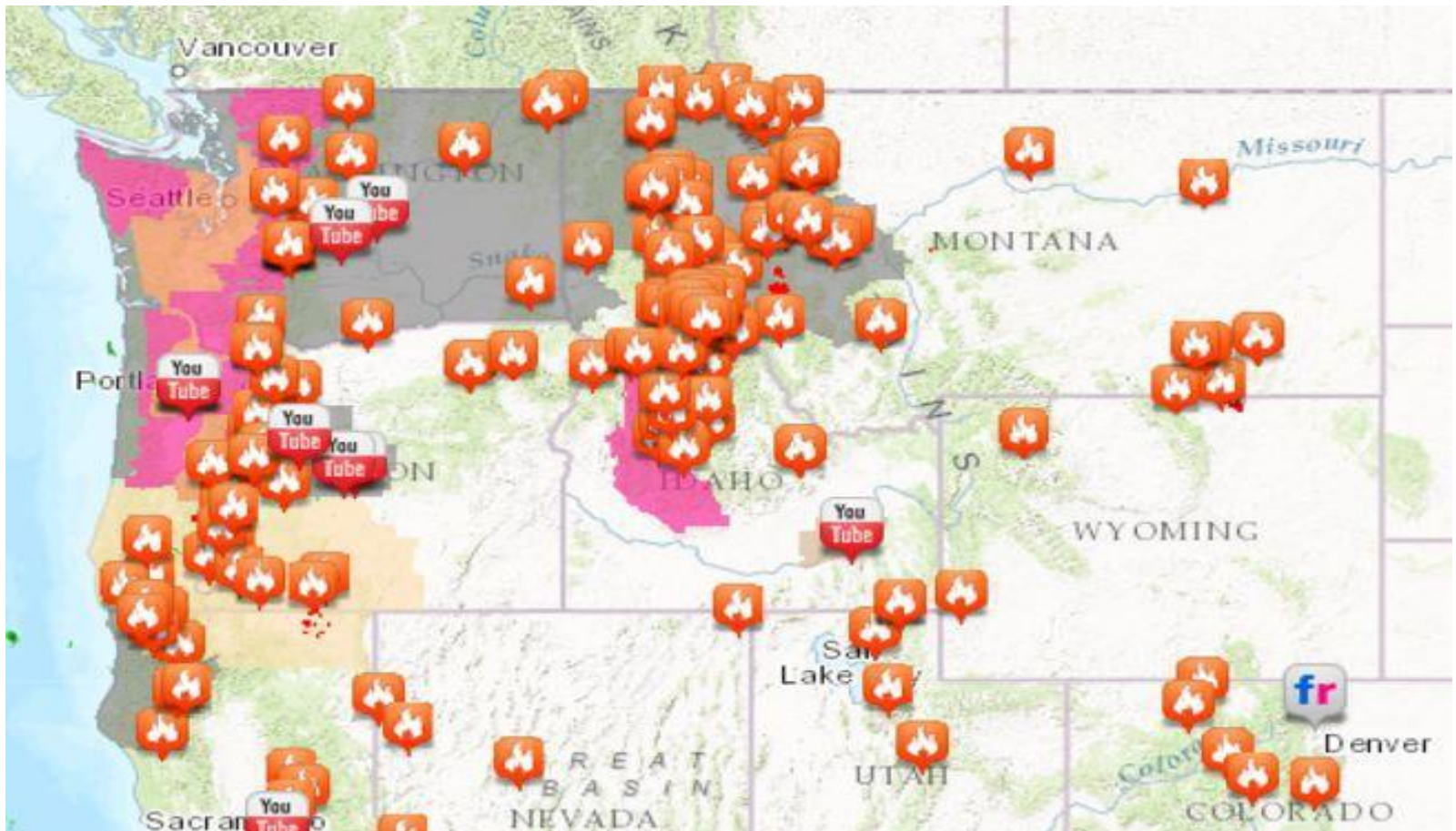
# Four Pillars of Disaster Animal Planning

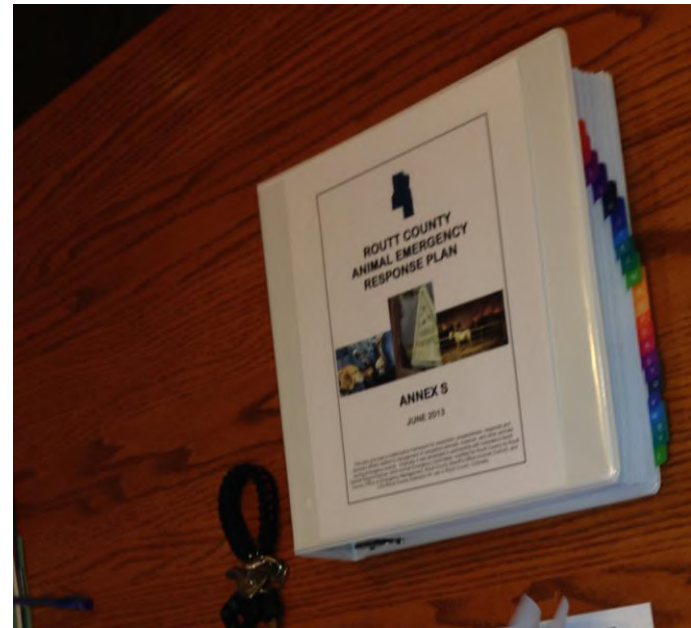


# All Disasters Start and End Locally

- Clean water, good feed and solid fences
- Carcass Disposal

- Public Health Concerns

# Longer term Goals

- Disaster shelters are not for long term housing
- Pets relinquished in housing shortage
- Feed for livestock more expensive.
- Diseases in stressed animals
- Continued public health concerns with contaminated pastures and water supplies.
