Glasgow - June 2024, BARTA Conference Incidents Involving Animals - Global Solutions to Tackle Local Problems

- Conference delegates enthusiastically endorsed the formation of an International Community
 of Practice (InCOP) to provide the leadership, cohesion and 'international glue' to join up
 regional activity and achieve greater impact

International Community of Practice (InCOP)



Vision

That communities worldwide possess knowledge, skills and capability to safeguard animals during emergency, disaster and conflict



Mission

To ensure all involved in planning and response to incidents involving animals, have access and affiliation to a network of like minded individuals for the benefit of mutual awareness, support and development.

Goals

- 1. Establish a mechanism through which Community members can connect and communicate
- 2. Create **opportunities** for face to face interactions between members, on a regional national and international basis
- 3. Provide opportunities through the network for collaborations and provision of mutual support

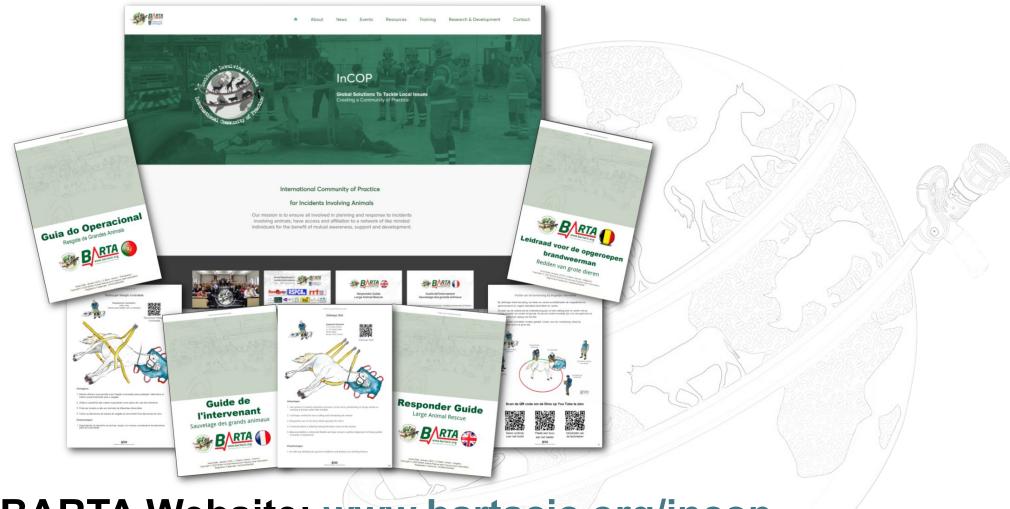
